#### **Group Size**

The maximum amount of groups per day depends on the program you choose.

## How far in advance should I call?

We suggest making reservations six months to a year in advance during the busy seasons (April-May; August- October), although sometimes reservations can be made up to two weeks in advance.

#### **Cancellations**

Any cancellations or changes to a reservation must be made one month in advance. Programs booked less than a month before the program date cannot be cancelled or changed after program is confirmed with payment.

### **Team Development Course**

The Teams Course is a group of initiatives which challenge a group to focus on the processes needed to achieve a goal, concentrating on how participants function within a group, while providing them with tools for growth.

**1/2 Day (4 hours)**......\$290 per group **All Day (8 hours)**.....\$545 per group

### **High Ropes Course**

The High Ropes Course is an adventure 30 feet up in the trees. Participants learn what motivates them to trust and to succeed. This adventure teaches them how to encourage each other as they play on a series of unique initiatives. Participants must be in **7th grade** or above.

**1/2 Day (4 hours)** ......\$400 per group

### 1/2 Day Combination Programs

Combine the Team Development Course with either Climbing Tower, Crate Climbing or Power Pole.

\$400 for the first group and \$290 for each additional group

Max number of groups per 4 hour combo program: Climbing Tower and Crate Climbing up to 3 groups Power Pole up to 2 groups

### **All-Day Combination Programs**

\$545 per group

Combine the Team Development Course with either:

High Ropes

or

Pick one or two of the following: Climbing Tower, Power Pole or Crate Stacking

## **Power Pole**

The Power Pole allows participants to face individual fears with the support of their team by scaling up a 35-foot pole.

Minimum grade: 7th

## Climbing Tower

The outdoor Climbing Tower has two sides with four routes of varying difficulties, and is adaptable for all skill levels. Minimum grade: **3rd** unless parent/guardian is present.



### **Crate Climbing**

New! Stack, climb, stack steady... whoooah. With the support of your team, you can climb high on a stack of crates. Minimum grade: 3<sup>rd</sup> unless parent/guardian is present.
